DIRECTIONS

Directions from Route 3 North:

Take Exit #32 (Drum Hill Rotary). Proceed straight through 1st set of lights off exit ramp. At 2nd set of lights, bear left following signs for Route 4 South toward Chelmsford Center. At the 3rd set of lights, turn left and then bear right onto Route 4 South (North Road). Police Department is the 1st driveway on the right just before the McCarthy Middle School, after you get onto Route 4 (North Road).

Directions from Route 495 North:

Take Exit #33 (Route 4 / North Road). Turn left at end of exit ramp onto Route 4 (North Road). Follow Route 4 approximately 1.5 miles. Police Department will be on your left after the McCarthy Middle School, just before the Drum Hill Rotary.

Directions from 495 South:

Take Exit for Route 3 Northbound from 495 South. Follow directions from Route 3 above.

PLEASE NOTE:

DO NOT PARK IN THE REAR LOT. DO NOT PARK IN THE DRIVEWAY ENTRANCE TO THE POLICE STATION, NOR IN THE “15 MINUTE ONLY” PARKING SPACES. FREE PARKING IS ALLOWED ON OLD NORTH ROAD (ON-STREET PARKING).
