

## LIFE MEMBERSHIP

C.A.A.O. Regular member, both past and present, having at least, fifteen years of employment in the Connecticut Assessment Profession and active involvement in the C.A.A.O., may, upon retirement from the Assessment Profession, be eligible for a Life Membership, the year following the expiration of their regular membership.

Any C.A.A.O. Member shall, in writing, submit to the Professional Designation and Awards Committee, a resume or letter detailing the candidate's contribution to C.A.A.O. A C.A.A.O. member may not nominate himself/herself.

Said submission must be made to the Professional Designation and Awards Committee by the last business day in March for the Spring Meeting or the last business day in September for the Fall Meeting.

Upon review and majority vote, the Professional Designation and Awards Committee shall cause this Life Membership to be presented to the recipient at the Annual Spring or Fall Meeting of C.A.A.O.

The Executive Board and recipients shall be notified of Life Memberships to be presented, at least two weeks prior to such presentation.

Life members shall be entitled to all rights, privileges and benefits that regular members enjoy.

Life members shall not be required to pay dues, as long as he or she is not actively employed in the Connecticut Assessment Profession. If at any time the life member becomes eligible for regular membership, by being employed in the assessment profession, his or her life membership shall be temporarily suspended until said person is no longer eligible for regular membership. The Professional Designation and Awards Committee shall report such suspension to the Membership Committee. Upon eligibility of life membership again, said person will resume his or her privileges. Again, the Professional Designation and Awards Committee shall report said eligibility to the Membership Committee.

The Professional Designation and Awards Committee shall cause to be published in the Assessorreporter, immediately preceding the Spring and Fall Meeting, a notice detailing the requirements of this Membership.
