

SCHOLARSHIP

Requests for a C.A.A.O. scholarship shall only be submitted upon the "[Scholarship Application Form](#)" as approved by the Professional Designation and Awards Committee.

Scholarship applications shall meet all of the following requirements.

1. Applicant shall be a member of C.A.A.O.
2. Applicant at the time of request for Scholarship shall be employed in a Connecticut Assessors Office.
3. Applicant shall provide a letter signed by the Finance Director or Chief Executive Officer of his or her employing municipality, stating that said Municipality will not pay for, nor reimburse the applicant for the full cost of the course for which the Scholarship is requested.

The course for which the Scholarship is requested shall pertain to the Assessing and/or Appraising Profession.

The decision to grant or deny a Scholarship and the amount of the Scholarship to be granted will be decided by a majority vote of the Professional Designation and Awards Committee. The Professional Designation and Awards committee shall, at least twice a year, cause to be published in the Assessorreporter, a notice of the Scholarship availability.

Upon awarding a Scholarship, the Professional Designation and Awards Committee shall cause to be published in the next issue of the Assessorreporter, a report detailing said Award and it's recipient,
