Currently I am a member of the Ethics Committee, the Education Committee, past president of the Hartford Area Assessors Association (2015-2018), Litchfield Area Assessors Association (2002-2004), and the senior UCONN instructor for CCMA Course IV (Revaluation).

I am a recipient of the CAAO Distinguished Service Award.

I received a Bachelor of Science Degree in Political Science from Florida Southern College in 1978.

After graduation I was employed by the New York State Division of Equalization and Assessment as Real Property Information System Specialist in Albany, NY. My primary duties involved training assessors in the use of a state supported software system for assessment administration and computer assisted mass appraisal.

I left state service in 1991 and was appointed as the sole assessor in the Town of Bethlehem, NY, a suburb of Albany. I worked there for approximately 2 years before being hired by Sabre Systems, a national revaluation contractor as a regional manager in New York. During my time with Sabre I supervised a number of complex revaluation projects such as in the Town of Colonie (29,000 parcels), City of Albany (30,000 parcels), and City of Syracuse (44,000 parcels).

I moved to Connecticut in 1999 and continued my work with Sabre Systems. In 2000, I was appointed Assessor by the City of Torrington. Since that time I have served as the assessor for the Town of Stratford, Town of Southington, and City of Danbury. While in Southington I was appointed Tax Collector and attained status as a Certified Connecticut Municipal Collector. Currently, I hold the position of Assessor for the Town of New Milford.
